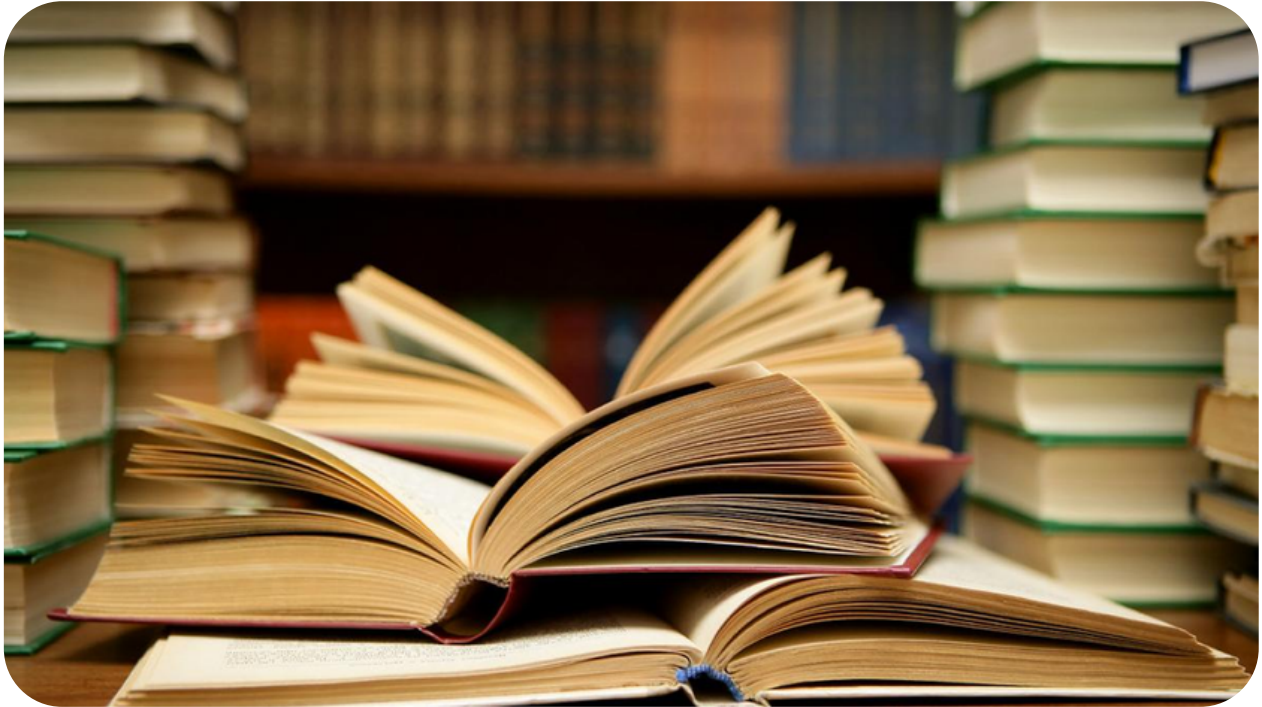
- Skating

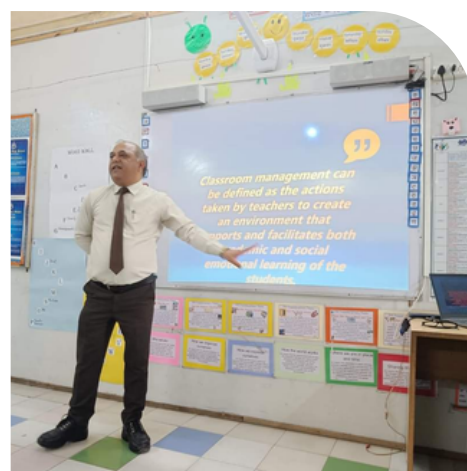


WORKSHOP: CLASS MANAGEMENT CONDUCTED BY : MR S C SHARMA
